

Did you know...

Dog Guard receivers function best when the Dog Guard batteries are replaced once every four months?



Dog Guard 6 volt silver oxide batteries are used in the DG3000, DG5000, DG9000 and DG9XT receivers.

Dog Guard batteries are tack welded cells, that keep the cells from expanding in the receiver. This assures that the cells are constantly in tact with each other.

Do not use other batteries as they will inhibit the receiver performance and could void your warranty.

Troubleshooting your receiver...

When the receiver is not working...

Verify that the battery is in the receiver correctly. The plus side must be up.

Check that the battery cap is not too tight.

The battery cap should be hand tightened and then with a dime or flat headed screwdriver, turn the battery cap ¼ of a turn. When the battery cap is over tightened, it may short the receiver out. In addition, it mis-shapes the o-ring, which allows water to seep into the battery compartment.
